- Please arrive 10 min before your presentation start time to set up.
- Presentation can be given in French or English.
- The presentation should include a brief review of the measurement techniques used in the TP, the major sources of error, and results obtained during the TP.
- The presentation will be followed by 10 minutes of questions mainly on the presentation; Questions on any other component of the course must also be considered.
- Each member of the group will be awarded an individual mark which counts for up to 40% of their final mark.
